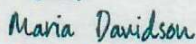

Dear Chancellor Reyes, I am writing to request your approval in compliance with the Conflict of Interest Law on Spousal Hire, so that the university can continue the appointment of my spouse Scott Davidson as the Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs with a concurrent appointment as Professor with tenure in the Department of Languages, literatures, and Cultures (LLC) in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts (HFA) for which I serve as Dean.

In his role as Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs, Professor Scott Davidson is supervised by Farshid Hajir, Senior Vice Provost C Dean of Undergraduate Education. The position of Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs is a full-time position in the Provost's office. As such, Professor Davidson will have no specifically required assigned research, service, or teaching duties in HFA while he is serving as Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs. However, since Professor Davidson will also have a concurrent appointment in LLC which is housed in HFA, he will be a faculty member in HFA, with all the rights and privileges that come with that appointment. Therefore, in order to comply with university policies and state ethics laws, I have sought and obtained the support of my supervisor, Provost Fouad Abd-El-Khalick, to recuse myself from all supervisory duties related to the performance of Scott Davidson as a faculty member in LLC or in any other capacity. As such, I will not participate in any personnel actions related to Professor Davidson, such as tenure, promotion, annual faculty report, requests for leave, evaluation for awards/honors, etc. and I request that Provost Abd-El-Khalick assign any and all such tasks to an appropriate person other than myself as he sees fit. I am concurrently filing a disclosure from with the State Ethics Commission to the same purpose. I therefore respectfully request your determination regarding this disclosure for the next 12-month period. I intend to file such a disclosure on an annual basis.

Dear Dean Davidson:

I acknowledge receipt of your Disclosure of Financial Interest form, dated January 15, 2026, and Memorandum, dated January 14, 2026. You request permission to allow the Provost's Office to continue the appointment of your spouse, Scott Davidson, as the Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs with a concurrent appointment as Professor with tenure in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts, Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures. The salary for this 12-month period (March 3, 2026 – March 2, 2027) will be \$197,885.00, at 100% FTE.

As further detailed in your Disclosure and Memorandum, although Professor Davidson will not have any specific duties as a faculty member in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts, Department of Languages, Literatures and Cultures, there are occasions where you ordinarily would be called upon to oversee personnel actions related to Professor Davidson, and you have asked your supervisor, Provost Fouad Abd-El-Khalick, to assign all such tasks to another appropriate person. According to Senior Vice Provost and Dean of Undergraduate Education Farshid, Hajir's Memorandum, dated December 16, 2025, he will continue to directly supervise Scott Davidson's performance and assign his duties which include leading, managing, and facilitating collaboration and strategic planning to align programs with the University's strategic vision for interdisciplinary education and lifelong learning.

Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 268A, Section 6, in part, prohibits a state employee from employing immediate family members and from compensating them for services rendered except when you "assign the particular matter to another employee [...], in which case it shall not be a violation for [. . . you] to participate in the particular matter."

My determination, which allows the Provost's Office utilization of your spouse's services for one year (March 3, 2026 – March 2, 2027), must be reviewed and reevaluated prior to any further appointment. Please submit your request to the Chancellor of the Amherst campus to make such a review and reevaluation by January 4, 2027, if you wish the Provost's Office to continue to employ your husband, Scott Davidson, as an Associate Provost of Interdisciplinary Programs with a concurrent appointment as

Professor with tenure in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts, Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures, beyond March 2, 2027.

The statute requires you to advise the Ethics Commission of the nature and circumstances of the particular matter and make full disclosure of that financial interest. As directed by statute, I am sending a copy of this written determination letter along with your memorandum and disclosure form to the State Ethics Commission for filing.

Professor Scott Davidson serves, under my direction, as the Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs. He also has an underlying faculty appointment as Professor in the Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures in the College of Humanities & Fine Arts (HFA). Scott Davidson's spouse, Lupe Davidson, serves as the Dean of the College of Humanities & Fine Arts.

Scott Davidson's performance will be directly supervised by me, Farshid Hajir, Senior Vice Provost and Dean of Undergraduate Education. I assign his duties and evaluate his performance. These duties include leading, managing, and facilitating collaboration and strategic planning to align programs with the university's strategic vision for interdisciplinary education and lifelong learning. The programs under Scott Davidson's leadership include the University Without Walls program (UWW), the Bachelor's Degree Independent Concentration Program (BDIC), as well Early College and Pre-College Programs. None of these programs is housed in HFA.

Dean Lupe Davidson will be excluded from any of Prof. Scott Davidson's personnel actions, such as tenure review, Annual Faculty Reports, Periodic Multi-Year Reviews, grant proposals, evaluation for internal or external awards and honors, etc. All such matters relating to Professor Scott Davidson which are internal to the college of Humanities and Fine Arts (HFA) and would be ordinarily handled by the Dean of HFA would be assigned to an appropriate Associate Dean in HFA or another person as determined by Dean Lupe Davidson's supervisor, Provost Fouad Abd-El-Khalick.
