Dear Attorney Douglas:

I have received the petition of Dr. Bharani Padmanabhan appealing the nonresponse of the Board of Registration in Medicine (Board) to his request for public records. G. L. c. 66, § 10A; see also 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1). Specifically, Dr. Padmanabhan submitted a request for various records primarily related to cosmetic procedures and “statements of allegation” within the possession of the Board. Claiming to not yet have received a response, Dr. Padmanabhan petitioned this office and this appeal was opened as a result.

Subsequent to the intervention by a staff member of the Public Records Division, I learned that a representative from the Board intends on providing a written response to Dr. Padmanabhan to his respective request. Accordingly, the Board is ordered to provide Dr. Padmanabhan with a response made in accordance with the Public Records Law, its Access Regulations within 10 business days. It is preferable to send an electronic copy of the response to this to this office at pre@sec.state.ma.us. Dr. Padmanabhan may appeal the substantive nature of the Department’s response within ninety days. See 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1).
