Dear Ms. Buruca:

I have received the petition of Andrew Ryan, of the *Boston Globe*, appealing the nonresponse of the Suffolk County District Attorney's Office (Office) to a request for public records. <u>See</u> G. L. c. 66, § 10A; <u>see also 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1)</u>. On July 26, 2022, Mr. Ryan requested "[d]igital copies of all emails, text messages, memos, and all other communication sent to or from any Suffolk County District Attorney employee from May 1, 2020, up through the 7/25/2022 that includes [an identified] ... name..."

Claiming to not yet have received responsive records, Mr. Ryan petitioned this office and this appeal, SPR22/2052, was opened as a result.

Despite being notified of the opening of this appeal, it remains unclear whether the Office has provided a response. Accordingly, the Office is ordered to provide Mr. Ryan with a response to the request, provided in a manner consistent with this order, the Public Records Law and its Regulations within ten (10) business days. A copy of any such response must be provided to this office. It is preferable to send an electronic copy of this response to this office at pre@sec.state.ma.us. Mr. Ryan may appeal the substantive nature of the Office's response within ninety (90) days. See 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1).
