On July 3, 2012, Police Commissioner Edward F. Davis executed a Settlement Agreement with Police Officer Sean Deery ID# 11597, assigned to the Bureau of Field Services/District C-6 , Org.# 43060 for a violation of Rules 102 §4 (Unreasonable Judgment) (4 counts); 102 §4 (Neglect of Duty); 320 §23 (Courts) (3 counts); 320 §24 (Courts) (3 counts); and 309 §4 (Collection and Identification of Physical Evidence) of the Boston Police Department Rules and Procedures arising out of IAD Case No. IAD 2011-0538.

On more than one occasion, Officer Deery submitted an overtime slip with an end time that was later than his court appearance. Additionally, Officer Deery duplicated efforts to obtain a search warrant for cell phones and he altered a Notice to Appear that resulted in the unnecessary presence of other officers in court. In resolution of this matter, Officer Deery has accepted a thirty (30) working day suspension with ten (10) working days to serve and the balance to remain in abeyance for one (1) year from the date of execution of the Agreement:

Officer Deery will serve the suspension on July 13; July 14; July 30; July 31; August 1; August 4; August 5; August 6; August 18, and August 19, 2012.
