On March 13, 2017, Police Commissioner William B. Evans executed a Settlement Agreement with Officer Shana Cottone, ID# 106714, assigned to BFS/District A-7, Org. # 41070, in resolution of the following charges:

<u>IAD2011-0108</u>—On or about February 28, 2011, Officer Cottone failed to provide her name upon request. Additionally, Officer Cottone was made aware of an injury complaint from a person in her custody and failed to provide her with medical attention. Officer Cottone's conduct was in violation of Rule 102 §20 (Self Identification) and Rule 318 §2 (Prisoners) of the Rules and Procedures of the Boston Police Department.

<u>IAD2012-0144</u>—On or about April 4, 2012, Officer Cottone transported a civilian in her department cruiser and allowed him to visit with the suspect without authorization, in violation of Rule 103A §12 (Officers Assigned to Department Vehicles, Passengers) and Rule 318 §16 (Prisoners-Authorized Visitors) of the Rules and Procedures of the Boston Police Department.

<u>IAD2012-0380</u>—On or about September 30, 2012, Officer Cottone engaged in a verbal and physical altercation while under the influence of alcohol in violation of Rule 102 §§3 (Conduct Unbecoming), 14 (Alcohol Off Duty0 and 35 (Conformance to Laws) of the Rules and Procedures of the Boston Police Department.

In resolution of the three (3) cases detailed above, Officer Cottone has accepted a thirty (30) working day suspension, with ten (10) working days to serve and the balance to remain in abeyance for one (1) year from the date of execution of the Agreement.

Officer Cottone will serve the suspension from March 15, 2017 through March 21, 2017 and March 27, 2017 through April 2, 2017.
